The camp took place at Uzi and served the following villages:

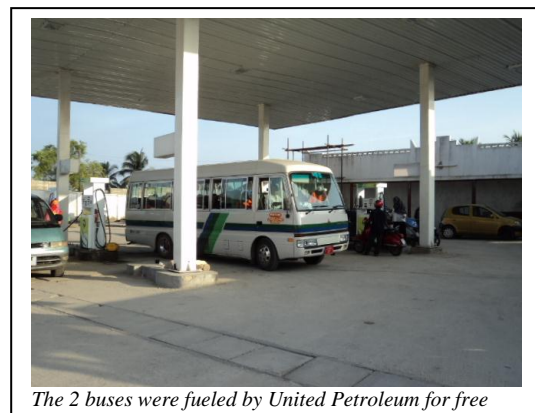

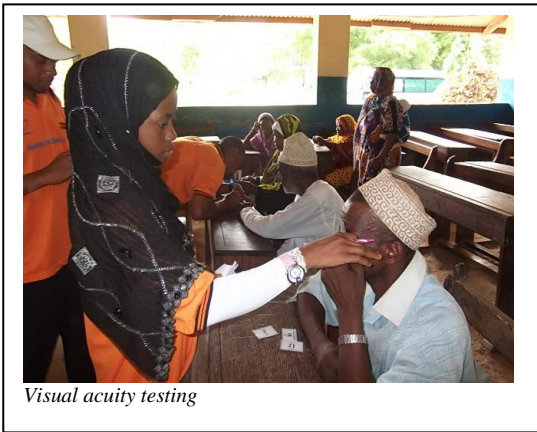

The camp had many elderly, who needed support;

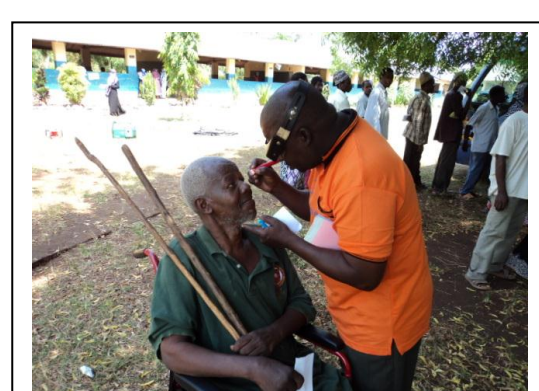
