Soccer as an opportunity

Soccer is a universal language talked all over the world and is striking children in different parts of the world, in different life circumstances, coming from poor or rich families.

When you will walk around through Zanzibar at Mnazi Moja ground in the late afternoon you will find children on every field and beach playing football together. With bare feet they run over the sand and through the grass dreaming of becoming the new Ronaldo or Messi. Most of the children in Zanzibar are victims of poverty and don't have many opportunities to make something out of their lives.

Sports including soccer is far more than a luxury or a form of entertainment. Access to and participation in sports is a human right and essential for individuals of all ages to keep themselves active, healthy and integrated in the society. Sports is critical to a child's development. It teaches core values such as cooperation and respect. It improves health and reduces the likelihood of disease. Sports brings individuals and communities together, bridging cultural or ethnic divides.



Ujamaa Soccer Kids Academy – where it is coming from?

The academy was founded by a small group of former national football players and old members of the Ujamaa Sports Club in 2015.

The main "trigger" was and is up to now the former national football player **Mussa Khamis Mussa** (**BAUCHA**), who played football in the seventies in Ujamaa Sports Club as well as in the National Team for his home island Zanzibar.

Since 2015 the Ujamaa soccer kids academy is supported by the German help organization Go for Zanzibar (GOZA) NGO.

Mission


Ujamaa Soccer Kids Academy provides the opportunity for children of poor families in the district of Rahaleo to play soccer while learning health, physical and social development life skills.

Vision

Ujamaa Soccer Kids Academy will be the leading kids program as well as kids soccer team in the district of Rahaleo/Zanzibar, creating a professional environment, where children can do sports in a safe surrounding and under professional observation and be empowered in their personal skills.

Objectives

- Provide sports sessions as regular, weekly activities.
- Organize workshops in different health topics like HIV protection, first aid, Malaria protection, general health.
- Organize excursions for the children to the East Coast, to Changu island or other places to strengthen the team spirit.
- Support the families with school material and equipment.
- Organize a family day per year to involve the parents and siblings of the kids and connect them to the academy.
- Care for the environment in our district Rahaleo by organizing "TAKA TAKA PARTIES"





Ujamaa Soccer Kids Academy – Situation 2018



In 2018 we relaunched the academy. At the moment we build the organizational foundation and a professional structure to run the academy sustainable. We are working with 25 children and want to expand the academy as soon as possible according to the support and funds we will try to get from local donors as well as from international NGOs.

Our offer and the activities of the academy shall reach the children of very poor families of the district Rahaleo/Zanzibar.



Ujamaa Soccer Kids Academy – Fundraising & Public relations

Funds have to be collected from local donors in Zanzibar as well as from fees of the parents (example: 2,000 TSH per child/per month).

To support fundraising activities information will be provided on the website www.ujamaasoccerkids.com as well as on print flyers.

The board of the academy will try to get free air time at Radio Zanzibar to inform the public about the activities.

A professional structure for public relations will be established together with our cooperation partner GOZA NGO.
